Submission Procedure:

You are invited to submit, <u>on or before March 1, 2010</u>, a brief proposal about your case study. The proposal should include a cover page with the name, affiliations, and contacts of the authors (names should not appear in the following pages), as well as 1-2 single spaced pages covering the company name, the focus of the case, and a brief summary and the mission of the case idea including the management area(s) covered. Upon acceptance of your proposal, you will be invited to submit the final case. Full cases are expected to be submitted by <u>April 15, 2010</u>. Cases will be subject to a blind peer review process, which will not take more than 8 weeks. The casebook is projected to be released in 2011.
