Call for Papers

The 6th annual ILAIS (Israel Association for Information Systems) conference will be held on **July 2, 2012** at the University of Haifa. The Program Committee invites researchers to submit extended abstracts and panel proposals.

Submission Guidelines

Faculty members, research students and industry researchers in the IS field are encouraged to submit by **March 11, 2012** a research paper abstract or a panel proposal (800-1,200 words, in English, in one of the following formats: MS Word, RTF or Open Office) to ILAIS2012@gmail.com. Authors must grant ILAIS the right to publish the abstracts or proposals online prior to the meeting, but retain all other copyrights. This arrangement allows you to publish the complete version elsewhere.

Research paper abstracts (research in progress or recently completed research) should include: title, author(s), introduction, objectives, method, results, and conclusion. The structure of theoretical/conceptual papers can be adjusted as needed.

Panel proposals should include: title, description of the panel, names, short (~50 words each) bios of 3-5 discussants, and their respective positions on the proposed topic.
