
The fifth IASTED African Conference on Health Informatics (Africa HI 2014) is an international forum for researchers and practitioners interested in the advances and application of Health Informatics.

SUBMISSIONS

Submit your abstracts via the website: www.iasted.org/conferences/submit-812.html. Abstracts should be a maximum length of 250 words.

All submissions should be in Adobe Acrobat (pdf) format. The abstracts must be received by **April 1**, **2014**. Receipt of the abstract will be confirmed by email.

Please complete the online initial paper submission form, designating an author who will attend the conference and providing four key words to indicate the subject area of your paper. At least one of the key words must be taken from the list of topics provided under "Scope."

All submissions to IASTED conferences must be previously unpublished and may not be considered for publication elsewhere at any time during the review period. Authors are limited to a maximum of three submissions. Authors are responsible for having their abstracts checked for style and grammar prior to their submission. Abstracts may be rejected if the language level is not satisfactory.

Notification of acceptance will be sent via email by **May 15, 2014**. Final abstracts are due by **June 1, 2014**. Registration and final payment are due by **June 15, 2014**. Late registration fees or abstract submissions will result in the abstract(s) being excluded from the conference proceeding.

REVIEWING

All submissions to this conference will be double-blind peer reviewed by at least two members of the International Program Committee and related technical committees. Acceptance will be based primarily on originality, significance, technical soundness, presentation, and references. The conference chair makes the final decision on the acceptance or rejection of the abstracts.
