#### **PURPOSE**



The papers must be received by **April 1, 2014**. Receipt of the paper submission will be confirmed by email.

Please complete the online initial paper submission form, designating an author who will attend the conference and providing four key words to indicate the subject area of your paper. At least one of the key words must be taken from the list of topics provided under "Scope." Initial paper submissions should be full papers, approximately eight pages long. All papers submitted to IASTED conferences must be previously unpublished and may not be considered for publication elsewhere at any time during the review period. Authors are limited to a maximum of three paper submissions. Authors are responsible for having their papers checked for style and grammar prior to their submission. Papers may be rejected if the language level is not satisfactory.

Notification of acceptance will be sent via email by **May 15, 2014**. Final manuscripts are due by **June 1, 2014**. Registration and final payment are due by **June 15, 2014**. Late registration fees or paper submissions will result in the paper(s) being excluded from the conference proceedings.

#### **REVIEWING**

All papers submitted to this conference will be double-blind peer reviewed by at least two members of the International Program Committee and related technical committees. Acceptance will be based primarily on originality, significance, technical soundness, presentation, and references. The conference chair makes the final decision on the acceptance or rejection of the paper.

#### **FINAL PAPERS**
