How to Submit Papers

Carefully read the submission guidelines at and submit your paper electronically through our <u>online submission</u> <u>system</u> (https://www.easychair.org/conferences/?conf=ictforafrica2014) on or before February 28th 2014. ICT4Africa 2014 submissions, publication and editorial committee will maintain very strict rules on submissions formats and deadlines. Paper which fail to use the submissions template will be rejected without review. Authors should read submission guidelines (http://www.ictforafrica.org/) before submitting their papers.

A formal notification of paper acceptance will only be issued after authors have addressed reviewer's comments as recommended by the review process. For papers to appear in the proceedings, at least one author must register and pay the registration fee applicable to his/her category of presentation. Letters of Invitation to ICT4Africa 2014 will only be issued after author(s) registration has been confirmed. An online and hard copy version of the conference proceedings for all tracks and submission categories shall be made available. Authors of some selected papers will be requested to submit extended versions of their work for publication in an edited book and Special issue of the African Journal of Information Systems dedicated to ICT4Africa after the conference. For consideration for the best paper award in any of the submission categories, full manuscript must be submitted by **March 31**st 2014.
