- Qualified for appointment at the rank of Associate Professor with tenure

- Evidence of excellence in undergraduate teaching
- Evidence of excellence in active research, publication, and scholarship in the areas of information security, networking security and emerging technology.
- Experience in collaborative grant writing and development

Responsibilities include leading the Program in enhancing teaching and research in information technology/security, conducting research and scholarship activities; securing grant and outside funding; mentoring junior faculty; preparing for ABET professional accreditation; teaching undergraduate courses in the Bachelor of Science in Information Technology program both on-line and in-person; engaging in outreach and service activities; participating in curriculum and program development; actively serving on and chairing department and university committees. USF Sarasota-Manatee is the primary campus for this position; however, this position may also teach on other USF campuses or off-campus locations. Appointment is for a 9-month, tenured position, and includes an excellent benefits package.
