### Qualifications:

The successful candidate will have an earned doctorate (by August 2015) in Operations Management, Supply Chain Management, Management Sciences, Operations Research or related disciplines such as Information Systems with quantitative experience in one or more of the following areas: quantitative analysis with special emphasis on statistics, Project Management, or supply chain management. The candidate should have a demonstrated record of quality research and the potential for excellence in teaching. Prior work experiences that use related skills are desirable, though not necessary.

### **Responsibilities:**

This faculty position will serve the mission of Morgan State University and the Earl G Graves School of Business and Management through the activities of teaching, intellectual contributions, and service. The person holding this position will be responsible for developing and teaching undergraduate and graduate courses in project management, supply-chain management and information systems. Teaching assignments will include courses in introductory statistics, and depending on background and qualifications, may include courses in production and operations management, project management, supply chain management, and enterprise information systems. The ability to use analytic and statistical tools such as SAS, SPSS is deemed essential. The ability to work with SAP, R, and Matlab is desirable. Engagement in multidisciplinary work with faculty with very diverse backgrounds is anticipated.
