Whom are we looking for:

- You have a very good Master's degree in information systems or related fields (e.g. business administration, business informatics, psychology, social sciences) or you graduate in one of these areas during the next months.
- You enjoy conceptual, empirical and creative work.
- You have excellent communication skills.
- You are fluent in English. German or the willingness to learn the language are an asset.
- For post-doctoral applicants: A very good PhD in information systems, business informatics or thematically related field. Promise to publish in leading international journals. Proven capacity to attract research funds is a plus.
