INFORMS Session: Artificial Intelligence for Cybersecurity

To promote the AI track, we invite you to submit your papers, abstracts, or posters to the 2019 INFORMS Annual Meeting to be held at the Washington State Convention Center, Seattle, Washington on October 20-23, 2019. The deadline for us to enter presenters into our invited session is **May 10th** and the deadline for submitting your complete abstract is **May 15th**. Thus, if you are interested in contributing to our session, we encourage you to respond to this call at your earliest time.

DESCRIPTION

The next generation of Artificial Intelligence (AI) and Machine Learning (ML) are increasingly incorporated in cybersecurity solutions. Experts predict that, over time, companies will incorporate AI into every cybersecurity product portfolio. While AI and ML increase the defenders' capability to detect and prevent abnormal behavior patterns, attackers are also using AI and ML to learn about a target's vulnerabilities and launch attacks. In this session, we solicit high-quality original research papers, both theoretical and empirical, that address the issues of AI aid, misuse and threat in cybersecurity in different contexts such as business, healthcare, education, politics, and economics.

Topics may include but are not limited to the following:

- The state of AI for cybersecurity
- AI applications in various security aspects
- Machine learning/deep learning algorithms to detect cyber threats
- Methodological approaches of open source machine learning
- Improving the success rate of detecting cyber attacks
- Cognitive AI security: Collaboration between AI and human intelligence
- Dark side of AI, misuse and AI threat
- Better practices for AI to prevent or defense a cyber-attack
- Are signatures and intrusion patterns enough?
- AI governance and privacy issues
- Government regulation and AI cybersecurity
- Other issues pertaining to AI cybersecurity

This year, the theme of the meeting lies on new developments of augmented technologies and their impacts which blends the growing role of Artificial Intelligence & Analytics techniques for understanding natural and artificial systems with computing and communication technologies to drive decision making for enriching our personal lives and enhancing our professional activity.
