Full Professor (W3) of Information Systems and Digital Technologies

at the Institute of Interorganizational Management & Performance to be filled as of April 1, 2024.

The successful candidate (m/f/d) conducts research and teaching on digital transformation from the perspective of business and information systems engineering. Within the range of topics and methods of business and information systems engineering, the candidate will ideally take a more technical view of the design, development, evaluation, and use of information systems and algorithms. Applicants should be recognized for internationally visible research and relevant peer-reviewed publications in high-ranking journals, and they must have proven the ability to raise third-party funds. It is expected that the professor will participate in the further development of the research profile of the Faculty in the field of digital transformation and will have the ability to network with other professors in the Faculty. Participation in the focus area “Work, Digitalization and Sustainability” and in the cross-faculty Computational Science Hub is desirable.

The successful candidate should be able to offer courses in German and English in the Faculty’s degree programs, especially in Information Systems, Digital Business Management, Business Administration and Economics, and Management. Participation in the doctoral study program is encouraged.

The position offers attractive conditions for first-time full professor appointees. Faculty and University offer an excellent environment for teaching and research, for example, in collaborative research projects. Prerequisites for applicants are habilitation or an equivalent research and teaching record which may have been established during a Junior or Assistant Professorship.

The advertised position is tenured. If appointed as full professor for the first time, the University of Hohenheim reserves its right to probationary employment. With equal qualifications, preference will be given to candidates with disabilities.

The University of Hohenheim seeks to increase the proportion of women in research and teaching and therefore strongly encourages female scientists to apply.
