Starting in 2006, this is now the eight conference in its series. WIS 2022 seeks high-quality contributions based both on scientific research and practical experience. The conference is multidisciplinary in nature, gives room for qualitative and quantitative analysis, empirical surveys, case studies as well as for conceptual work; thereby making WIS 2020 a perfect forum for exchange of information and ideas.

The final form (on-line, off-line, hybrid) will be decided in May at the latest.

WIS 2022 will accept full conference papers.

All accepted **full conference papers** will be published in Springer series CCIS (Communications in Computer and Information Science). Best papers, as further developed versions, will be published also in a special Issue of International Journal of Telemedicine and Clinical Practices and Finnish Journal of eHealth and eWelfare in Autumn 2023. The full papers are expected to be 4000 - 5000 words long.
